Update: In-Person Worship Suspended

March 13, 2020

Dear Victory Community,

I want to update you on what's happening at Victory in light of the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak in our area. Governor Evers has asked that we limit non-essential gatherings of more than 250. This afternoon, he announced the closing of all K-12 schools in the state.

As you know, I've also reached out to local city officials and spoken with several other area pastors and our Leadership Team to gain perspective on how to best move forward. At this time, we have determined that it is in the best interest of all of you, as well as the staff and volunteers at Victory, to suspend in-person worship services. Additionally, all classes offered at Victory will be canceled until further notice.

In order to still share God's word with you and help you grow in faith, we will continue to offer live-streamed services that are consistent with our regular services. You will also be able to access archives of our messages online by Tuesday afternoons following each service. Both our live stream and archives can be accessed at **victoryofthelamb.com**.

Additionally, we will continue to share Jesus with you and our community through our Social Media accounts. You can follow Victory on Facebook (@victoryofthelamb), Instagram (@victoryofthelamb), and Twitter (@victoryfranklin) for encouragement in this difficult time in our community.

Unfortunately, there is little we can do to control the virus or the impact it's having on our church and community. However, we can be confident that God is in control of all things. Find confidence of this in God's word: ***But now, this is what the Lord says— . . . "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine" (Isaiah 43:1).***

Please take time to pray for our community, those affected by the disease, and our church during these next few weeks. When we pray, we need not fear; we can be confident that God hears our prayers and works out all things for our eternal good.
