Letter to Volunteers on COVID-19 Procedures

March 12, 2020

Dear Victory Volunteers,

We are extremely grateful for your service to our community and at Victory. We want to care for our congregation in all respects, including the physical well-being of our community. To that end, we are asking you, our Victory volunteers, to take precautions to keep yourself and others safe, especially considering recent developments with the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

While we recognize and appreciate your commitment to serving at Victory, we want you to be mindful of the guidance from the Centers for Disease Control, including:

- Stay home when you are sick or feeling under the weather.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. To help you ensure you've washed your hands sufficiently, say the Lord's Prayer or sing the ABCs while washing your hands.
- Avoid contact with those who are sick whenever possible.
- If you have a suppressed immune system or are otherwise in a high-risk category for infection, we encourage you to stay out of large groups and watch out for your health and safety.

If you are feeling ill or otherwise do not feel it safe for you to serve on your team for a worship service, please contact your team leader ASAP to let them know you are unable to serve. You can always contact one of the pastors if you are unable to contact your team leader.

Additionally, we will begin implementing sanitization protocols to protect you and others while you are at Victory. These are in addition to our regular cleanings done once per week. As part of your role, you may be asked to help with sanitizing areas of church in which you serve. Your team leader will communicate more details about this to you shortly.

Even when we fear, God is near to us.
