## Official Statement on COVID-19 Procedures

March 12, 2020

Dear Victory Community,

At Victory, we want to care for our congregation in all respects, including the physical well-being of our community. To that end, we are asking you, our Victory family, to take precautions to keep yourself and others safe, especially considering recent developments with the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

Please be mindful of the guidance from the Centers for Disease Control, including:

- Stay home when you are sick or feeling under the weather.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. To help you ensure you've washed your hands sufficiently, say the Lord's Prayer or sing the ABCs while washing your hands.
- Avoid contact with those who are sick.
- If you have a suppressed immune system or are otherwise in a high-risk category for infection, we encourage you to stay out of large groups and watch out for your health and safety.

If you, for whatever reason, decide to remain home during worship, we encourage you to consider streaming our services on Sunday mornings. You will also be able to access archives of our messages online by Tuesday afternoons following each service. Additionally, we have begun implementing sanitization protocols to protect you while you are at Victory. These are in addition to our regular cleanings done once per week. These precautions include:

- Cleaning and sanitizing surfaces (toys, switches, handles, etc.) in the Victory Kids wing after Sunday services;
- Switching out toys in the Victory Kids wing between services to ensure toys are clean;
- Cleaning and sanitizing the Victory Café area between services; and
- Sanitizing technology utilized during services (iPads, microphones, etc.).

At this time, there are no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Milwaukee County or the surrounding areas.
